

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Christmas is just around the corner. As the restrictions continue to change rapidly, throughout the country, this will be a very different Christmas than a lot of us are used to. We are blessed in our faith to be able to pray and worship as one community, one family, even when we cannot be gathered together in person. The Christmas Mass times can be found in the bulletins included in your packs, and even if you are not able to attend any of these Masses, I encourage you to join us from your own home using the Mass sheets included in this pack.

It is a strange time indeed when we are unable to welcome Jesus in our world with jubilant music and celebration, but perhaps this change of pace offers us a new take on this special time in the Church's year. The first nativity, as we hear in the Gospels, was a very simple affair. Jesus was not born into a rich family and the people of Bethlehem probably didn't notice the new arrival, yet in the quiet of that stable, the world was given the mightiest of gifts. Isaiah wrote about one who would arrive that would be a 'Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father and Prince of Peace.' These names are a great example of the many roles God plays in our lives. He is our guide, our protector and one who loves us beyond our comprehension. So just as Mary and Joseph welcomed our Lord and Saviour in the stable on a quiet night, let us also welcome Jesus in our homes and hearts this year.




