DBS Drop-in Session - Sunday 24th November

Anyone who is helping out within the church in roles that require a Disclosure and Barring Service certificate must have a re-check every three years. By the end of March 2020 those volunteers who do not have a current DBS certificate will be asked to step down from their role until their DBS check has been completed.
