Looking back at a year of services

It has been almost a year since we were able to open up the churches after the first Lockdown. We started with Private Prayer on Monday 20th July 2020 at St. Godric's.

Since then we have had 353 services including:

- 34 Private Prayer sessions
- 287 Masses, including the Good Friday service
- 24 Requiem Masses, Funeral services and Receptions, for 20 parishioners we have lost
- 8 First Holy Communion Masses, for 89 children from our three Primary schools

In total, 11,861 people have attended our services over the 12 months.

ONGOING FAITH WITNESS AGAINST HASSOCKFIELD

In October, the Home Office plans to open an Immigration Removal Centre at Hassockfield on the site of the former Medomsley Detention Centre. This will be for 80 women seeking asylum in the UK. The proposal is inhumane, unjust and incompatible with our faith which calls us to recognise the intrinsic dignity of each person. These women are people like ourselves who have the right to a place of safety and to be treated with respect and compassion. A monthly prayer vigil will be held at the barrier to Hassockfield on the first Sunday of each month at 3pm starting on Sunday 1st August. This will last for about 30 minutes and will incorporate a time of silent witness. Please support this with your prayer and, if at all possible, come along.
